RACIAL JUSTICE CHALLENGE

This May, YWCA Spokane Invites You to Take the Racial Justice Challenge.

A free, 10-day virtual series exploring how harmful narratives shape what we believe, who we trust, and how systems respond to entire communities.

HOW IT WORKS

Over ten days, registered participants will receive daily content grounded in research, local data, and community context. Dedicate 15-60 minutes a day to digest the content and hold time to reflect and discuss these topics with friends, family, or colleagues.

No prior experience with racial justice topics is required. All that is needed is curiosity, a willingness to sit with difficult questions, and a commitment to showing up for each of the days of learning.

Guided throughout by a restorative framework, content is focused on understanding and repairing harm rather than assigning blame.

2026 FOCUS

This year's Challenge examines how harmful information operates at every scale, from the narratives circulating in national media, to the assumptions we carry into everyday interactions, to the policies and systems that have been shaped by false and distorted stories about communities of color.

Participants will build practical skills for recognizing and responding to misinformation, disinformation, and malinformation, and will explore how those forms of harmful information connect to the lived experiences of Spokane's communities.
